


## A: REMOVAL

## **B: INSTALLATION**

1) Install the crankshaft sprocket.

- 3) Install the timing belt assembly. <Ref. to ME(STi)-48, INSTALLATION, Timing Belt Assembly.>
- 4) Install the timing belt cover. <Ref. to ME(STi)-45, INSTALLATION, Timing Belt Cover.>
- 5) Install the crankshaft pulley. <Ref. to ME(STi)-
- 44, INSTALLATION, Crankshaft Pulley.>
- 6) Install the V-belt. <Ref. to ME(STi)-41, INSTAL-LATION, V-belt.>

## C: INSPECTION

- 1) Check the sprocket teeth for abnormal wear and scratches.
- 2) Make sure there is no free play between sprocket and key.
- 3) Check the crankshaft sprocket notch used for sensor for damage and contamination of foreign matter.
