
10.Combination Base Switch Assembly

A: REMOVAL

- 1) Remove the driver's airbag module. <Ref. to AB-12, REMOVAL, Driver's Airbag Module.>
- 2) Remove the steering wheel. <Ref. to PS-17, RE-MOVAL, Steering Wheel.>
- 3) Remove the steering column cover.
- 4) Remove the combination switch. <Ref. to LI-9, REMOVAL, Combination Switch (Light).> and <Ref. to WW-7, REMOVAL, Combination Switch (Wiper).>
- 5) Loosen the four screws and remove the roll connector.
- 6) Loosen the three screws.



7) Disconnect the connector and remove the combination base switch assembly.

B: INSTALLATION

- 1) Install in the reverse order of removal.
- 2) Align the attaching direction of roll connector with the steering wheel, before installation of steering wheel. <Ref. to AB-18, ADJUSTMENT, Roll Connector.>

C: INSPECTION


1. COMBINATION BASE SWITCH ASSEMBLY

Perform the inspection for the following items and replace with a new one, if any damage is found.

 Crack or deformation of combination base switch assembly or roll connector

2. PARKING SWITCH

Measure the parking switch resistance.



Switch position	Terminal No.	Standard
OFF	2 and 4	Less than 1 Ω
ON	1 and 4	Less than 1 Ω
